

CAREERSOURCE BROWARD AGENCY RESPONSE TO **COVID-19**



Since late March 2020, over **42 million** Americans have filed for unemployment benefits. (This marks the largest and most dramatic rise in claims on record since the U.S. Department of Labor started tracking unemployment data beginning in 1967.)

More than 187,919 out of the 1.6 million Floridians Who Have Filed For Unemployment Are Broward County Residents.

To assist both Broward County residents and employers during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, CareerSource Broward has:



Created a dedicated webpage (careersourcebroward.com/coronavirus) with workforce resources available to employers and workers who have been impacted by the crisis.



Provided several remote services, including virtual appointments with employers and job seekers.



Distributed more than **10,200** Reemployment Assistance applications and sent a link to the application to hundreds of community organizations.



Conducted **259** online career development professional workshops and orientations.



Trained **15** staff members to assist with PIN resets in order to help customers process their reemployment claims.



Two weeks after the closure of our career centers, started a series of online virtual job fairs to help connect job seekers with employers with vacant positions.
