## Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region Not Seasonally Adjusted September 19, 2025

• The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade County) was 2.9 percent in August 2025. This rate was equal to the region's year ago rate of 2.9 percent. The region's August 2025 unemployment rate was 1.5 percentage points lower than the state rate of 4.4 percent. The labor force was 1,446,713, with no change over the year. There were 42,078 unemployed residents in the region.

## Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metro Division

- In August 2025, nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD was 1,345,200, an increase of 16,100 jobs (+1.2 percent) over the year.
- The Mining, Logging, and Construction (+6.3 percent); Education and Health Services (+2.8 percent); Financial Activities (+2.5 percent); and Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+1.8 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+5,700 jobs); Mining, Logging, and Construction (+3,800 jobs); and Financial Activities (+2,400 jobs) industries.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+1.8 percent) industry.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the second fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Mining, Logging, and Construction (+6.3 percent) industry.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the third fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Financial Activities (+2.5 percent) industry.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+6,100 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+5,700 jobs); Mining, Logging, and Construction (+3,800 jobs); Financial Activities (+2,400 jobs); Other Services (+500 jobs); and Government (+300 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Professional and Business Services (-1,700 jobs); Manufacturing (-800 jobs); and Information (-200 jobs).
- The Leisure and Hospitality industry was unchanged in jobs over the year.
