This Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Sub-Grant Agreement is fully supported by the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$2,021,353. Pursuant to the Steven's Amendment 100% of the funds support this program are federal funds.

THIS AMENDMENT TO SUB-GRANT AGREEMENT NO. 2024-2025-CR-WIOA-ISY-2335, which was entered into the 21st day of August, 2024 by and between CAREERSOURCE BROWARD hereinafter referred to as "CSBD", the administrative entity and fiscal agent for the CareerSource Broward Council of Elected Officials (hereinafter "Council") and the Broward Workforce Development Board, Inc., (hereinafter "BWDB") having its principal office at 2890 W. Cypress Creek Road, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309 and THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA hereinafter referred to as "SUB-GRANTEE", existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida as a public body politic, having its principal office at 600 S.E. Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301, to begin on the date this Agreement is executed by the parties and to terminate June 30, 2026.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, CSBD and Sub-Grantee entered into an Agreement effective August 21, 2024 to serve In School youth under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014; (WIOA 29 U.S.C. Sec. 3101, et. Seq. Public Law 113-128); and

WHEREAS, CSBD wishes to amend the existing Agreement to extend the term of the Sub-Grant Agreement with Sub-Grantee through June 30, 2026, for the continuation of the youth program and to provide funds for the period of the extension as described herein; and

WHEREAS, at their meeting on April 24, 2025, the CSBD governing boards approved an Amendment to Agreement No. 2024-2025-CR-WIOA-ISY-2335 extending the Agreement for an additional one-year period.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and obligations herein contained, and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter stated, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Article 3, Fiscal Management, Section 3.2.1 Total Compensation, Section 3.2.1 a. is replaced in its entirety to incorporate the underscored language below as follows:

3.2.1 Total Compensation

a. The compensation awarded for the In-School Youth program funded under this sub-grant agreement shall be Two Hundred Thousand, Dollars and zero cents (\$200,000.00), for the period <u>July 1, 2025 through</u> <u>June 30, 2026</u> in accordance with the budget attached hereto as Exhibit A.

- 2. Article 5, Program Requirement, Section 5.17 Sub-Grant Agreement Term, Subsections 5.17.1, 5.17.2 and 5.17.3 are replaced in their entirety to incorporate the underscored language below as follows:
 - 5.17 Sub-Grant Agreement Term
 - 5.17.1 The term of this Sub-Grant Agreement shall begin on the date it is fully executed by both parties and shall end on June 30, 2026.
 - 5.17.2 The term of this Sub-Grant Agreement may be extended for <u>three</u> additional one-year periods.
 - 5.17.3 At the end of each CSBD program year, if a new sub-grant agreement, for the same program services as provided for herein, is approved by the CSBD governing boards, or the term of this Sub-Grant Agreement is renewed by the CSBD governing boards for an additional one year period, the term of this Sub-grant Agreement shall automatically be extended from <u>June 30</u>, <u>2026</u> until such time as the new Agreement or amendment extending this Agreement, is approved and executed by Sub-Grantee, not to extend beyond September 30 of the calendar year following the end date of the immediately previous Agreement.
- 3. Article 7, Scope of Work, Section 7.1 Program Description In-School Youth (ISY) is replaced as follows:
 - 7.1 Program Description In-School Youth (ISY)
 - Sub-Grantee shall conduct an ISY program for <u>seventy-five (75)</u> WIOA eligible in-school youth, who are high school seniors.
- 4. Article 7, Scope of Work, Section 7.2 Recruitment, is amended by deleting the header for Sub-section 7.2.1 and the provisions in Sub-paragraph 7.2.1 a. and replacing them in their entirety to incorporate the underscored language below as follows:
 - 7.2.1 Sub-grantee shall recruit <u>75</u> youth.
 - a. Sub-Grantee shall recruit sufficient youth resulting in <u>75</u> high school senior youth enrollments. The youth shall be in the second semester of their senior year and be expected to receive their High School Diploma in May/June of the program year, each year that this Sub-grant Agreement is in effect.

- 5. Article 7 Scope of Work, Section 7.3.9 is amended to add new Sub-paragraphs a. and b. and to incorporate the underscored language below as follows:
 - 7.3.9 The Individual Service Strategy and Career Pathways Plan
 - a. Following eligibility determination, staff shall develop an Individual Service Strategy Plan (ISS) <u>using the template in EmployFlorida</u> and Career Pathways plan with each youth to be enrolled in the program. These plans will be used to identify the participant's program activities, and track their progress in the individual components of the program design. The ISS shall be modified to reflect participant's progress in program activities and achievement of program goals as necessary. <u>Modifications shall be entered into EmployFlorida</u>. This mutual planning process will enable each participant to develop ownership of the plan and learn, through the process, how to make choices and actions that will lead directly to specific outcomes.
 - b. <u>Sub-grantee shall assure that the template provided by Florida Commerce and found in EmployFlorida substitutes for any previous form used to develop the ISS and any modifications to the ISS.</u>
- 6. Article 7, Scope of Work, Section 7.4. Program Services to be Provided to the Youth, Sub-section 7.4.1 Sub-paragraph k., is replaced in its entirety to incorporate the underscored language as follows:
 - 7.4.1 To encourage youth to complete high school and to keep them attached to their academic studies and environment all youth shall be placed in a work experience learn the connection between education and work.

- k. Sub-Grantee shall be responsible for tracking and monitoring participants' hours of work on a weekly basis, through the maintenance of signed time sheets or upon full implementation of the CSBD electronic timesheets, and assuring that they are timely and correctly approved.
- 7. Article 7, Scope of Work, Section 7.10. Performance, Sub-section 7.10.2 and Sub-paragraph a, is amended to replace the section in its entirety and to include the underscored language as follows:
 - 7.10.2 Enrollment Goals Sub-grantee shall enroll seventy five (75) youth
 - a. The <u>seventy-five (75)</u> youth to be served by Sub-grantee shall be identified and enrolled during the first semester of the school year.

- 8. All provisions of the Sub-grant agreement entered into on August 21, 2024, which are not in conflict with this Amendment, shall continue to be enforced in accordance with the terms and conditions therein.
- 9. This Amendment and all its attachments are made a part of said Contract. The effective date of this Amendment shall be the date on which it has been signed by all parties.
