

Florida's November Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in November 2024, up 0.1 percentage point from the October 2024 rate, and up 0.3 percentage point from a year ago. There were 376,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,015,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in November.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 10,010,500 in November 2024, an increase of 61,500 jobs (+0.6 percent) over the month. The state gained 163,900 jobs over the year, an increase of 1.7 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.4 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Eight of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in November.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+34,300 jobs, +2.3 percent); leisure and hospitality (+31,400 jobs, +2.4 percent); construction (+28,700 jobs, +4.5 percent); total government (+26,500 jobs, +2.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+23,800 jobs, +1.2 percent); other services (+16,100 jobs, +4.3 percent); professional and business services (+8,000 jobs, +0.5 percent); and information (+800 jobs, +0.5 percent).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were manufacturing (-3,200 jobs, -0.8 percent) and financial activities (-2,500 jobs, -0.4 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In November 2024, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.3 percent), followed by Miami-Dade County (2.4 percent), and Gulf County (3.2 percent).
- Citrus County had the highest unemployment rate (5.5 percent) in Florida in November 2024, followed by Hamilton County and Hendry County (5.2 percent each), and Highlands County and Sumter County (5.1 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

• In November 2024, all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+24,800 jobs, +1.9 percent), followed by the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+18,500 jobs, +1.2 percent), and the Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA (+16,900 jobs, +1.1 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
