Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region Not Seasonally Adjusted October 16, 2020

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 12.8 percent in September 2020. This rate was 10.5 percentage point higher than the region's year ago rate of 2.3 percent. The labor force was 1,459,773, down 29,061 (-2.0) over the year. There were 186,415 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (5.9 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (13.0 percent).
- In September 2020 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,135,400, a decrease of 76,600 jobs (-6.3 percent) over the year.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in financial activities (+1.5 percent) in September 2020.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in financial activities (+1,200 jobs) in September 2020.
- The industries gaining in jobs over the year were financial activities (+1,200 jobs) and mining, logging, and construction (+100 jobs).
- The leisure and hospitality (-30,100 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (-13,200 jobs); education and health services (-11,000 jobs); government (-10,500 jobs); professional and business services (-6,900 jobs); other services (-4,800 jobs); manufacturing (-900 jobs); and information (-500 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
