Overview of the CareerSource Palm Beach County Region Not Seasonally Adjusted July 18, 2025

• The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Palm Beach County region (Palm Beach County) was 3.9 percent in June 2025. This rate was 0.3 percentage point greater than the region's year ago rate of 3.6 percent. The region's June 2025 unemployment rate was equal to the state rate of 3.9 percent. The labor force was 779,860, up 1,718 (+0.2 percent) over the year. There were 30,748 unemployed residents in the region.

West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach Metro Division

- In June 2025, nonagricultural employment in the West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD was 702,800, an increase of 10,900 jobs (+1.6 percent) over the year.
- The Education and Health Services (+6.2 percent); Manufacturing (+2.7 percent); Information (+1.8 percent); Government (+1.5 percent); and Financial Activities (+0.6 percent) industries grew as fast or faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD had the second fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Education and Health Services (+6.2 percent) industry.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD had the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Education and Health Services (+7,200 jobs) industry.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD was tied for the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Manufacturing (+600 jobs) and Financial Activities (+300 jobs) industries.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+7,200 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+1,400 jobs); Government (+900 jobs); Professional and Business Services (+700 jobs); Manufacturing (+600 jobs); Financial Activities (+300 jobs); Information (+200 jobs); and Other Services (+200 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Leisure and Hospitality (-400 jobs) and Construction (-200 jobs).
