Overview of the CareerSource Palm Beach County Region Not Seasonally Adjusted June 20, 2025

• The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Palm Beach County region (Palm Beach County) was 3.4 percent in May 2025. This rate was 0.3 percentage point greater than the region's year ago rate of 3.1 percent. The region's May 2025 unemployment rate was 0.1 percentage point lower than the state rate of 3.5 percent. The labor force was 780,445, up 3,954 (+0.5 percent) over the year. There were 26,860 unemployed residents in the region.

West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach Metro Division

- In May 2025, nonagricultural employment in the West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD was 712,100, an increase of 9,400 jobs (+1.3 percent) over the year.
- The Education and Health Services (+5.4 percent); Government (+2.3 percent); Manufacturing (+2.2 percent); and Financial Activities (+0.4 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Education and Health Services (+6,300 jobs) and Professional and Business Services (+1,400 jobs) industries.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD had the second fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Education and Health Services (+5.4 percent) industry.
- The West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach MD was tied for the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Government (+1,500 jobs) industry.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+6,300 jobs); Government (+1,500 jobs); Professional and Business Services (+1,400 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+700 jobs); Manufacturing (+500 jobs); Financial Activities (+200 jobs); and Construction (+100 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Leisure and Hospitality (-800 jobs); Other Services (-300 jobs); and Information (-200 jobs).
