## Overview of the CareerSource Broward Region Not Seasonally Adjusted December 18, 2020

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Broward region (Broward County) was 7.3 percent in November 2020. This rate was 4.6 percentage point higher than the region's year ago rate of 2.7 percent. The labor force was 1,015,050, down 30,584 (-2.9) over the year. There were 73,879 unemployed residents in the region.
- In November 2020 nonagricultural employment in the Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Bch-Deerfield Bch Metro Division was 809,100, a decrease of 64,400 jobs (-7.4 percent) over the year.
- The financial activities (+0.3 percent) industry grew faster in the metro area than the statewide over the year.
- The Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Bch-Deerfield Bch Metro Division was tied for the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in financial activities (+200 jobs) in November 2020.
- The Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Bch-Deerfield Bch Metro Division the second fastest annual
  job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in financial activities (+0.3
  percent) in November 2020.
- The industry gaining in jobs over the year was financial activities (+200 jobs).
- The leisure and hospitality (-20,900 jobs); professional and business services (-10,800 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (-8,500 jobs); construction (-6,800 jobs); education and health services (-6,200 jobs); other services (-3,700 jobs); government (-3,400 jobs); manufacturing (-2,700 jobs); and information (-1,600 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
