Overview of the CareerSource Broward Region Not Seasonally Adjusted March 25, 2022

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Broward region (Broward County) was 3.2 percent in February 2022. This rate was 2.9 percentage points lower than the region's year ago rate of 6.1 percent. The region's February 2022 unemployment rate was 0.1 percentage point above the state rate of 3.1 percent. The labor force was 1,041,649, up 27,531 (+2.7 percent) over the year. There were 33,467 unemployed residents in the region.
- In February 2022 nonagricultural employment in the Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach Metro Division was 868,100, an increase of 40,600 jobs (+4.9 percent) over the year.
- The information (+9.2 percent) and government (+0.4 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach Metro Division had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in information (+1,800 jobs).
- The Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach Metro Division had the third fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in leisure and hospitality (+15.9 percent).
- The industries gaining in jobs over the year were leisure and hospitality (+12,600 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (+10,700 jobs); professional and business services (+8,200 jobs); financial activities (+3,500 jobs); information (+1,800 jobs); other services (+1,200 jobs); education and health services (+1,100 jobs); manufacturing (+1,000 jobs); government (+400 jobs); and construction (+100 jobs).
