

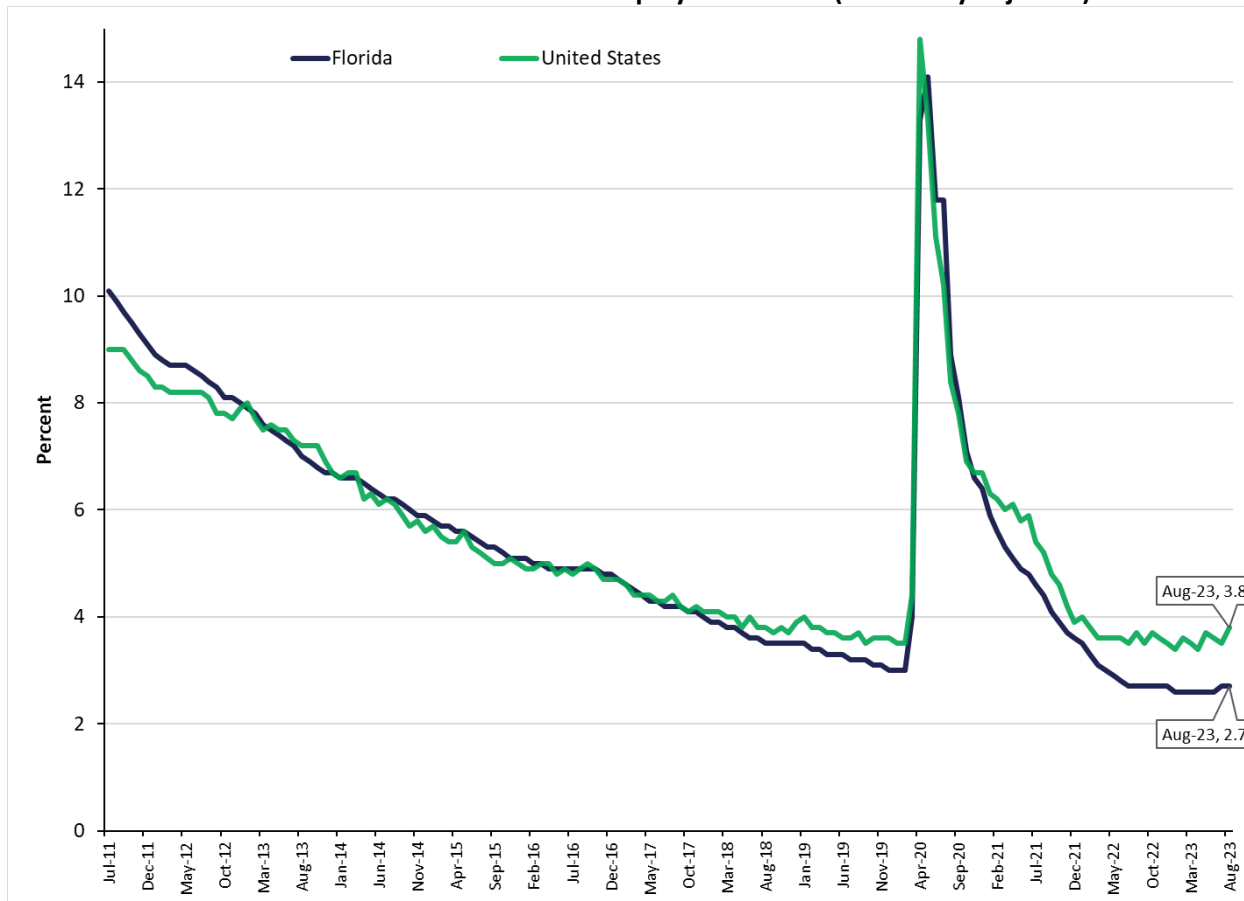

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### Florida's August Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.7 percent in August 2023, unchanged from the July 2023 rate, and unchanged from a year ago. There were 303,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,121,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.8 percent in August.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,778,000 in August 2023, an increase of 14,600 jobs (+0.1 percent) over the month. The state gained 270,300 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.8 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 2.0 percent over the year.

## **Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)**

- Nine of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in August.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+88,500 jobs, +6.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+53,900 jobs, +2.8 percent); leisure and hospitality (+43,800 jobs, +3.5 percent); total government (+25,700 jobs, +2.4 percent); professional and business services (+22,000 jobs, +1.4 percent); financial activities (+13,700 jobs, +2.0 percent); manufacturing (+13,100 jobs, +3.2 percent); other services (+5,600 jobs, +1.6 percent); and construction (+4,500 jobs, +0.7 percent).
- The industry losing jobs over the year was information (-400 jobs, -0.3 percent).

## **Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)**

- In August 2023, Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.9 percent), followed by Monroe County (2.0 percent), Okaloosa County (2.7 percent), St. Johns County and Bay County (2.8 percent each).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (6.3 percent) in Florida in August 2023, followed by Hamilton County (5.1 percent), Hardee County (4.9 percent), Highlands County and Citrus County (4.8 percent each).

## **Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)**

- In August 2023, all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+46,900 jobs, +3.2 percent), Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+43,000 jobs, +3.4 percent), and Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+38,400 jobs, +2.7 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
