


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Florida's December Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.5 percent in December 2022, down 0.1 percentage point from the November 2022 rate, and down 1.0 percentage point from a year ago. There were 271,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,761,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.5 percent in December.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,578,500 in December 2022, an increase of 21,400 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 440,000 jobs over the year, an increase of 4.8 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 3.0 percent over the year.

Florida's total nonagricultural and private sector employment surpassed the February 2020 (pre-pandemic) level in October 2021 and labor force surpassed the February 2020 level in June 2021. All nine major private sector industries have surpassed pre-pandemic employment levels.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Florida lost 1,282,500 jobs from February to April 2020 and has since gained back all jobs lost (+1,785,500 jobs).
- All ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in December.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included leisure and hospitality (+88,600 jobs, +7.4 percent); education and health services (+83,800 jobs, +6.2 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+82,700 jobs, +4.4 percent); professional and business services (+53,400 jobs, +3.6 percent); other services (+30,100 jobs, +8.7 percent); manufacturing (+27,400 jobs, +6.9 percent); financial activities (+26,000 jobs, +4.1 percent); construction (+25,500 jobs, +4.4 percent); total government (+14,200 jobs, +1.3 percent); and information (+8,400 jobs, +5.9 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2022, Miami-Dade County and Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.4 percent each), followed by St. Johns County (1.8 percent), and Wakulla County and Okaloosa County (1.9 percent each).
- Highlands County had the highest unemployment rate (3.6 percent) in Florida in December 2022, followed by Citrus County (3.5 percent), and Sumter County (3.4 percent).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2022, 23 of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+69,100 jobs, +4.8 percent), Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+61,000 jobs, +5.0 percent), and Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+53,300 jobs, +4.0 percent).
- One metro area in Florida experienced an over-the-year job loss: Sebring MSA (-100 jobs, -0.4 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
