


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Florida's October Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.7 percent in October 2022, up 0.2 percentage point from the September 2022 rate, and down 1.0 percentage point from a year ago. There were 285,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,750,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in October.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,542,500 in October 2022, an increase of 36,400 jobs (+0.4 percent) over the month. The state gained 457,400 jobs over the year, an increase of 5.0 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 3.6 percent over the year.

Florida's total nonagricultural and private sector employment surpassed the February 2020 (pre-pandemic) level in October 2021 and labor force surpassed the February 2020 level in June 2021. All nine major private sector industries have surpassed pre-pandemic employment levels.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Florida lost 1,282,500 jobs from February to April 2020 and has since gained back all jobs lost (+1,749,500 jobs).
- All ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in October.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included leisure and hospitality (+96,200 jobs, +8.1 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+92,000 jobs, +4.9 percent); education and health services (+76,800 jobs, +5.7 percent); professional and business services (+57,200 jobs, +3.8 percent); financial activities (+38,700 jobs, +6.1 percent); other services (+28,900 jobs, +8.5 percent); manufacturing (+28,600 jobs, +7.3 percent); construction (+21,100 jobs, +3.7 percent); total government (+9,600 jobs, +0.9 percent); and information (+8,100 jobs, +5.7 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2022, Monroe County and Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.7 percent each), followed by St. Johns County (2.1 percent), and Okaloosa County (2.2 percent).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (4.5 percent) in Florida in October 2022, followed by Highlands County (4.3 percent), and Citrus County and Charlotte County (4.0 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2022, 22 of all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+75,000 jobs, +6.2 percent), Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+72,400 jobs, +5.1 percent), and Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+64,200 jobs, +4.9 percent).
- One metro area in Florida experienced an over-the-year job loss: Sebring MSA (-300 jobs, -1.2 percent).
- One metro area in Florida was unchanged in jobs over-the-year: Homosassa Springs MSA.

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
