

Florida's October Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 2.8 percent in October 2023, unchanged from the September 2023 rate, and up 0.1 percentage point from a year ago. There were 318,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,174,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.9 percent in September.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,824,000 in October 2023, an increase of 28,400 jobs (+0.3 percent) over the month. The state gained 278,400 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.9 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.9 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Nine of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in October.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+90,100 jobs, +6.4 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+64,400 jobs, +3.3 percent); professional and business services (+36,100 jobs, +2.2 percent); leisure and hospitality (+28,900 jobs, +2.3 percent); total government (+25,500 jobs, +2.3 percent); financial activities (+17,800 jobs, +2.6 percent); construction (+8,300 jobs, +1.4 percent); other services (+6,600 jobs, +1.9 percent); and manufacturing (+4,800 jobs, +1.1 percent).
- The industry losing jobs over the year was information (-4,100 jobs, -2.6 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2023, Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.6 percent), followed by Monroe County (2.0 percent), Gulf County (2.7 percent), Okaloosa County and St. Johns County (2.8 percent each).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (5.1 percent) in Florida in October 2023, followed by Hamilton County (5.0 percent), Citrus County (4.6 percent), Hardee County and Highlands County (4.5 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

• In October 2023, all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (44,300 jobs, +3.5 percent), followed by the Tampa-Saint Petersburg-Clearwater MSA (+37,500 jobs, +2.5 percent), and the Jacksonville MSA (+31,200 jobs, +4.0 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
