

**Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
August 20, 2021**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 6.4 percent in July 2021. This rate was 8.6 percentage points lower than the region's year ago rate of 15.0 percent. The labor force was 1,414,934, up 104,195 (+7.9) over the year. There were 90,224 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (3.1 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (6.5 percent).
- In July 2021 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,145,000, an increase of 56,700 jobs (+5.2 percent) over the year.
- The leisure and hospitality (+26.7 percent); professional and business services (+9.5 percent); and financial activities (+6.8 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in leisure and hospitality (+26.7 percent) and financial activities (+6.8 percent).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in financial activities (+5,400 jobs).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in leisure and hospitality (+24,600 jobs) and professional and business services (+16,300 jobs).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in trade, transportation, and utilities (+9,000 jobs) and other services (+3,900 jobs).
- The industries gaining in jobs over the year were leisure and hospitality (+24,600 jobs); professional and business services (+16,300 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (+9,000 jobs); financial activities (+5,400 jobs); education and health services (+4,800 jobs); other services (+3,900 jobs); manufacturing (+800 jobs); and information (+300 jobs).
- The government (-4,900 jobs) and mining, logging, and construction (-3,500 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
