

**Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
July 16, 2021**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 6.9 percent in June 2021. This rate was 3.3 percentage points lower than the region's year ago rate of 10.2 percent. The labor force was 1,369,877, up 140,166 (+11.4) over the year. There were 94,920 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (3.5 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (7.1 percent).
- In June 2021 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,139,300, an increase of 45,300 jobs (+4.1 percent) over the year.
- The leisure and hospitality (+19.7 percent); other services (+12.3 percent); professional and business services (+10.4 percent); financial activities (+5.0 percent); and manufacturing (+3.0 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in other services (+5,300 jobs) and financial activities (+4,000 jobs).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in professional and business services (+17,500 jobs) and manufacturing (+1,200 jobs).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the third fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in other services (+12.3 percent).
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division had the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in leisure and hospitality (+19,100 jobs) and trade, transportation, and utilities (+7,300 jobs).
- The industries gaining in jobs over the year were leisure and hospitality (+19,100 jobs); professional and business services (+17,500 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (+7,300 jobs); other services (+5,300 jobs); financial activities (+4,000 jobs); manufacturing (+1,200 jobs); and information (+400 jobs).
- The government (-4,600 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (-3,400 jobs); and education and health services (-1,500 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
