

**Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
April 16, 2021**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 8.0 percent in March 2021. This rate was 5.8 percentage points higher than the region's year ago rate of 2.2 percent. The labor force was 1,332,066, down 48,411 (-3.5) over the year. There were 106,980 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (3.3 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (8.2 percent).
- In March 2021 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,137,900, a decrease of 82,500 jobs (-6.8 percent) over the year.
- The leisure and hospitality (-34,900 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (-19,400 jobs); education and health services (-10,400 jobs); government (-7,300 jobs); other services (-4,400 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (-2,100 jobs); information (-1,700 jobs); manufacturing (-1,300 jobs); financial activities (-900 jobs); and professional and business services (-100 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
