

Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
July 17, 2026

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade County) was 3.0 percent in June 2026. This rate was 0.4 percentage point greater than the region's year ago rate of 2.6 percent. The region's June 2026 unemployment rate was 1.6 percentage points lower than the state rate of 4.6 percent. The labor force was 1,418,006, down 2,455 (-0.2 percent) over the year. There were 42,023 unemployed residents in the region.

Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metro Division

- In June 2026, nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD was 1,351,000, an increase of 8,800 jobs (+0.7 percent) over the year.
- The Education and Health Services (+2.7 percent); Professional and Business Services (+2.2 percent); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+0.9 percent); and Leisure and Hospitality (+0.9 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+2,800 jobs) industry.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the second highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Professional and Business Services (+4,800 jobs) and Leisure and Hospitality (+1,400 jobs) industries.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the third highest annual job growth compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Education and Health Services (+6,100 jobs) industry.
- The Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD had the third fastest annual job growth rate compared to all the metro areas in the state in the Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+0.9 percent) industry.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+6,100 jobs); Professional and Business Services (+4,800 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+2,800 jobs); and Leisure and Hospitality (+1,400 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Financial Activities (-3,400 jobs); Government (-1,400 jobs); Other Services (-600 jobs); Manufacturing (-500 jobs); and Mining, Logging, and Construction (-400 jobs).
- The Information industry was unchanged in jobs over the year.
