

**Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
March 26, 2021**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 7.7 percent in February 2021. This rate was 6.1 percentage point higher than the region's year ago rate of 1.6 percent. The labor force was 1,360,430, down 72,657 (-5.1) over the year. There were 105,034 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (3.5 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (7.9 percent).
- In February 2021 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,125,900, a decrease of 110,400 jobs (-8.9 percent) over the year.
- The leisure and hospitality (-44,000 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (-25,700 jobs); education and health services (-11,500 jobs); government (-9,100 jobs); other services (-5,600 jobs); professional and business services (-5,200 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (-2,700 jobs); manufacturing (-2,300 jobs); information (-2,300 jobs); and financial activities (-2,000 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
