

**Overview of the CareerSource South Florida Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
March 15, 2021**

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource South Florida region (Miami-Dade and Monroe counties) was 7.9 percent in January 2021. This rate was 6.1 percentage point higher than the region's year ago rate of 1.8 percent. The labor force was 1,339,709, down 94,604 (-6.6) over the year. There were 106,442 unemployed residents in the region.
- Monroe County had the lowest unemployment rate (3.5 percent) in the CareerSource South Florida region followed by Miami-Dade County (8.1 percent).
- In January 2021 nonagricultural employment in the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall Metropolitan Division was 1,120,700, a decrease of 107,600 jobs (-8.8 percent) over the year.
- The leisure and hospitality (-42,500 jobs); trade, transportation, and utilities (-26,400 jobs); education and health services (-9,400 jobs); government (-9,300 jobs); professional and business services (-6,300 jobs); other services (-6,000 jobs); financial activities (-2,200 jobs); information (-2,100 jobs); mining, logging, and construction (-1,800 jobs); and manufacturing (-1,600 jobs) industries lost jobs over the year.
