- Submit all necessary documentation and make every effort to succeed

# Why Should You Keep Your Commitment?

If you do not fulfill your responsibilities while in the program, CareerSource

Broward must report to the DCF that you are not participating, which will lead to the following sanctions:



- You will lose your TANF benefits (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) for a period of time.
- You will lose your SNAP benefits (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) for a longer period, and other services such as childcare and training dollars.
