



#### Florida's October Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.6 percent in October 2021, down 0.2 percentage point from the revised September 2021 rate, and down 1.2 percentage points from a year ago. There were 491,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,590,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 4.6 percent in October.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,902,400 in October 2021, an increase of 41,500 jobs (+0.5 percent) over the month. The state gained 428,600 jobs over the year, an increase of 5.1 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 4.1 percent over the year.

The October 2021 total nonagricultural employment has not reached the pre-pandemic levels in February 2020.

#### Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Florida lost 1,269,200 jobs from February to April 2020 and has since gained back 86.6 percent of the jobs lost (+1,099,500 jobs).
- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,902,400 in October 2021, up 428,600 jobs compared to a year ago. All ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in October.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included leisure and hospitality (+135,100 jobs, +13.7 percent); professional and business services (+73,900 jobs, +5.5 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+70,600 jobs, +4.0 percent); education and health services (+49,700 jobs, +3.8 percent); financial activities (+31,000 jobs, +5.2 percent); other services (+28,900 jobs, +9.0 percent); construction (+17,900 jobs, +3.2 percent); manufacturing (+8,600 jobs, +2.3 percent); information (+8,200 jobs, +6.4 percent); and total government (+4,300 jobs, +0.4 percent).

#### Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2021, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.5 percent), followed by St. Johns County (2.9 percent), Wakulla County (3.1 percent), and Okaloosa County, Nassau County, and Santa Rosa County (3.2 percent each).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (6.3 percent) in Florida in October 2021, followed by Putnam County (5.9 percent), Highlands County and Hamilton County (5.4 percent each), and Osceola County (5.3 percent).

#### Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2021, 23 out of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+82,900 jobs, +7.0 percent), Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+75,500 jobs, +5.6 percent), and Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+69,300 jobs, +6.2 percent).
- In October 2021, The Villages had no change in employment over the year.

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
