Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be physically capable of performing the essential functions of the apprenticeship program and worksite, with or without a reasonable accommodation, and without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of the individual or others.
- Must be able to lift and carry 50 lbs.
- Must be able to read, write, and speak the English language in order to comprehend instructions on the job and in related training classes, and to ensure personal and co-worker safety on the job.
